



◆ **Question:** Jesus entered Jerusalem as a humble King. How do I respond to His kind of kingship—one marked by humility, not domination? Do I sometimes expect a different kind of Savior?



Day 4 – The Greeks Seek Jesus (John 12:20–26)

◆ **Question:** Jesus says that unless a grain of wheat dies, it remains alone. What in my life needs to "die" in order for me to bear the kind of fruit God desires?



◆ **Question:** Jesus was troubled, yet He remained committed to glorifying the Father. When I face fear or uncertainty, do I prioritize comfort or God's glory?



◆ **Question:** Some believed in Jesus but feared human rejection more than they feared God. What holds me back from full obedience—approval from others, fear, pride?

◆ **Question:** Jesus came as light to a dark world. Where do I still walk in darkness, and how can I more fully live in the light of His truth?
